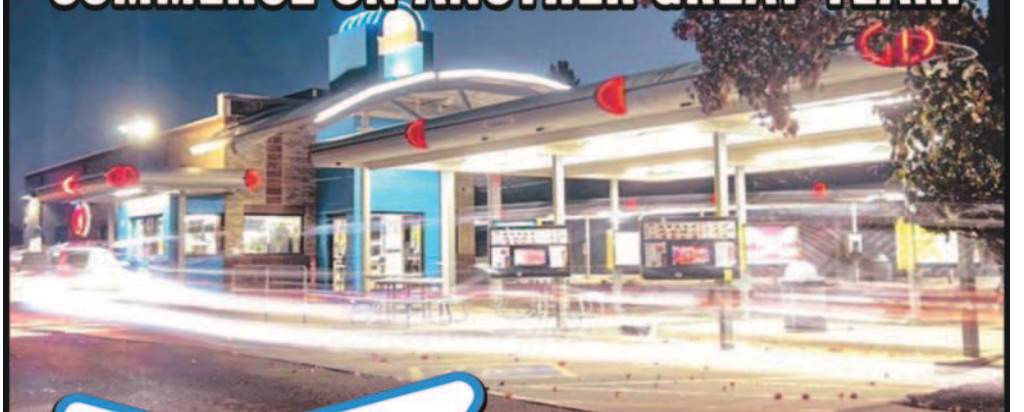

Dr. Joe Anna Hibler, Kiwanis Kid at Heart Award

Dr. Joe Anna Hibler has been an active member of Kiwanis since November of 1988. She has been involved with many projects Kiwanis has done including being a representative for the STEAM Program. Kiwanis members enjoyed hearing her read from the SW Women's handbook from the 40s and 50s.

She not only had a great influence through Kiwanis, but also on the hilltop at Southwestern Oklahoma State University. She served 11 years as president and completed a 41-year career in Oklahoma education. Thirty-seven of those years

spent on the SWOSU Campus.

Dr. Hibler came to SWOSU as a scholarship student in 1957. She completed a Bachelor of Science degree in business education in 1960. She then earned her master's degree in business education from Oklahoma State University in 1961. She taught her first four years at Altus High School and served as an adjunct instructor at Altus Junior College. In 1965, she returned to her alma mater as an instructor in the Division of Business. She completed her doctoral degree in 1971 at the University of Oklahoma. Dr. Hibler

later chaired the Office Administration/Business Education Department at SWOSU before becoming dean of the School of Business. In 1986, Hibler was named executive vice president for academic affairs. Four years later, Dr. Hibler was appointed SWOSU's 15th president. When she assumed her duties on July 1, 1990, Dr. Hibler became the first woman in 55 years to serve as president of a university in Oklahoma. Dr. Joe Anna Hibler retired June 30, 2001, as president of Southwestern Oklahoma State University.

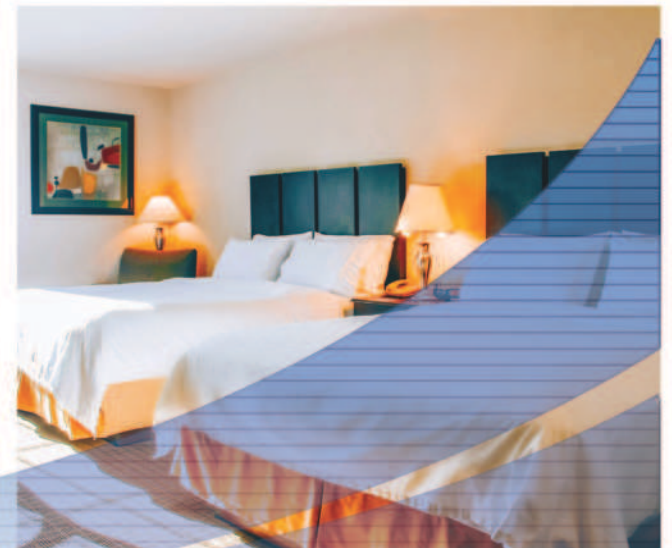

Small Business Society


