Taking a huge leap into a new venture and leaving behind security isn't something Alan Shoalmire took lightly and if it weren't for "cosmic" timing, he may still be waiting to chase his dream and may have never become the "Grill Sergeant."

Before attending Hot Dog University in Chicago in 2010, Shoalmire was a teacher. He taught fifth-grade math and Texas History for Navasota Independent School District. Additionally, he served in the United States Army.

Shoalmire believes everyone is entitled to several versions of themselves and he has always dreamt of owning a food truck. Unfortunately, the \$80-90K price tag was out of reach for him. Refusing to give up on his dream, Shoalmire researched and discovered owning a hotdog cart was the least expensive way to

get his foot in the door of the food industry.

The only formal training Shoalmire could find was at Hot Dog University in Chicago. In the weeklong course he learned the "art of the cart." He was taught various things from how to price hotdogs, health regulations, which products to use and which to avoid, how to manage inventory and much more. He even got to tour the Vienna Beef Hot Dog Factory. "Despite the horror stories you hear, I can assure you there aren't any lips, tongues or any other weird items in their hotdogs. They are pure beef cut from around the ribs and brisket area of the cow," explained Shoalmire.

After Shoalmire graduated from the University, a lot of time passed. He wrestled with the idea of leaving a job with benefits until he attended Living History Weekend at the Mu-

seum of the American GI. "A hotdog vendor was set up at the event and he was rolling in the cash," said Shoalmire. When business let up, he approached the vendor and mentioned that he was interested in getting in the hotdog business. "He just froze." What he said changed Shoalmire's life. "He said he had an extra cart he was needing to sell." Shoalmire drove to Waco and purchased the cart.

After 31-years in the military and an extensive teaching career, Shoalmire retired and began the hotdog business. The first day, on May 14, 2018, was "nerve-wrecking." The logo for his cart showed up with five-minutes to spare before the ribbon-cutting, and he was terrified no one would show up to eat.

Since that time Shoalmire has sold a countless number of hotdogs, and his array of menu items keeps customers returning for more. "I have one elderly couple that follows me everywhere. One time they even showed up to my house to see where I would be the following day," said Shoalmire. "I bet they have eaten 100 hotdogs."

The Grill Sergeant features hotdogs inspired by others. Shoalmire's favorite hotdog to make is the "Full Metal Jacket," named by his friend Dale. It's a jumbo hotdog with homemade chili, cheese, onions, relish, jalapeños and sauerkraut. He also has a hotdog inspired by local radio personality Kenny Graves called the "Willy," which is sausage topped with sautéed onions and bell peppers. Sometimes there are specialty items on the menu such as the bacon mac and cheese dog.

Shoalmire has learned, "don't get happy or sad too quick." He said, "tomorrow is another day and it's going to be different. I've gotten caught in the moment and anticipated every day to be great only to struggle the next day. There are other days that are slow, and it seems like they won't ever pick back up."

When not serving up the best hotdogs in Grimes County, Shoalmire enjoys writing a column in The Examiner, cleverly title "Off the Grill." He also is active at First Presbyterian Church where he and his wife sing in the choir.

One day Shoalmire would like to upgrade to a larger cart or food truck, and possibly be able to hire an employee. Regardless of what the future holds, he is where he wants to be and can't imagine being an employee again. "Owning my own business came at a perfect time in my life and was one of the best things I've ever done."

Grill Sergeant has one word of advice for anyone wanting to feast on the best hotdog in Grimes County, "Come on down an GETCHU-SOME!"

Brenda Meekins' passion and love for children inspired her and her daughter Krysten to pursue a business within the community that mirrored their passion for children and would give them a platform to make a difference within the community.

The childcare community quickly made an impact on the future business the mom and daughter were planning. Brenda said when other childcare facilities heard about her and her daughters' interest in opening an additional childcare center within Navasota, those centers rallied around the idea. "The childcare industry within our community was very receptive and extended a helping hand. They ensured us, if we needed anything, they were only a phone

call away," explained Brenda.

Brenda said they expressed the need for another childcare facility in the area because many of the current daycares were filled to capacity and had to turn children away. The overwhelming support they received was one of many confirmations Brenda said they needed that opening Creative Minds Childcare was truly their calling.

Further validation was the potential location of the facility. In the 1960s, a building was constructed at 110 Brewer Street that would serve the community for decades as the Navasota Public Library. The fact that they wanted to teach children and serve the community, the same reason the building was initially built, made the site a perfect choice. "It coincided with what we wanted to do and the timing of the building being available was further confirmation of the calling," stated Brenda.

The love of children was evident, the building was in place and the childcare facility received community backing. There was only one thing needed to bridge the gap to opening the facility – someone that knew how to run the daycare. "I had no idea what establishing a daycare entailed," said Brenda. "All I knew was I love children. I love helping, nurturing and teaching them." As far as the rules and regulations and all that goes into the business, Brenda said she didn't have all that knowledge.

Brenda knew someone that had the necessary knowledge and experience to operate a daycare, her classmate Felisa Randle. She reached out to Felisa hoping she could point her in the direction of a good childcare director, not expecting to hear that Felisa herself was available. That was one more confirmation of the calling as Felisa accepted the job and bridged the gap the daycare needed. "My part was easy—just building the daycare," explained Brenda. "It's like the quote from the movie Field of Dreams; if you build it, they will come."

ated with Brenda's daughter Krysten, however Brenda said she never knew her until she registered her children at daycare. "She told me when she heard I was opening a daycare she immediately knew that is where her children were going to be enrolled," said Brenda. One evening the parent opened up to Brenda and explained how she knew her children would be enrolled at the daycare.

Brenda recalls the conversation, "She said I remember you from when I was in kindergarten. I remember you attending every single activity Krysten had. You were very involved in the school and I always remember you being there. I remembered thinking one day when I am a mommy, I want to be just like you." Brenda said when she heard that, she knew it was another affirmation of her calling. "I can't thank her enough for sharing that story with me. I never knew what I did could have such an impact on someone."

The daycare celebrates its one-year anniversary Sept. 16 and has experienced great times such as a visit from the local fire department, but they have also experienced trying times in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. "If I could have predicted this pandemic, I may have delayed the opening for years if I decided to open at all," said Brenda. She said if it weren't for Felisa being the backbone through these times she is not sure if Creative Minds would still be open today.

Being named "Best Childcare Facility in Grimes County" is not something the daycare takes lightly. "I was absolutely flabbergasted by the announcement and was in total shock. We thank our community for supporting us through this difficult and trying time," said Brenda.

Despite earning the award in their first year, Felisa said they have their eyes set on becoming a "Texas Rising Star" daycare. Part of the recognition is opening the daycare to state-paid subsidies that helps less fortunate children attend the daycare. "One of the things Navasota Mayor Bert Miller challenged us to do when we announced we were opening a daycare is to obtain the Texas Rising Star distinction," said Felisa. In year two the daycare aims to move toward that goal.

As many medical practices moved towards a co-op approach to medicine, with multiple doctors in multiple clinics, Dr. Katie Blalock of Texas A&M Physicians in Navasota embraced the small-town doctor persona.

"I go to church with my patients, we see each other at the football games on Friday nights and that closeness is actually helpful because it builds a trust that is key," said Blalock.

Born and raised in Navasota, Blalock is a 2003 Rattler graduate who applied to medical school as a high school senior before attending undergrad, medical school and residency through Texas A&M University.

"I knew that I just wanted to do everything and that really is the key to family

medicine," Blalock said. "I always like to say 'I do newborns to nursing homes,' I like all age groups and I am always doing something different and I never know what is going to walk in the door."

According to Blalock, her studies in rural medicine have given her the tools she needs to treat a variety of conditions. She has enjoyed coming home to a small town where she can not only develop a rapport with people but also treat illnesses that may fall to the hands of specialists in other atmospheres.

"I think the beauty of a good family medicine physician is that you really can take care of the whole person," Blalock said. "It is essential that you have someone steering the ship; I have seen too often in this day and age that people will have a specialist for everything but they do not have that one person that actually communicates with everybody else and when they don't things get missed. Dealing with your own healthcare is challenging and you may forget something."

The trust that Blalock has developed with her patients allows her to know when it is time to call in an extra set of eyes and why she was named Best Family Physician and Best Medical Clinic for the last 3 years.

"When I get to the point where they need a specialist I will bring one in and I don't have a problem with that," said Blalock. "There are many things I can take care of and in this community, even though Bryan and College Station are 15 or 20 minutes away, some patients just do not want to leave town and I have to be the cardiologist or gastroenterologist and fulfill those roles and, frankly, my training allows me to do that"

To better assist Grimes County patients with their medical needs, Texas A&M Physicians offers obstetric services through the addition of Dr. Amanda Bray and Dr. Jill Cotter.

Blalock has noticed that an aging population, not just in Grimes County but throughout the country, is requiring more and more medical intervention. It is just this population that she has returned to treat, either within her office or in the local nursing homes.

"I have people who come to me from an hour or an hour and a half

away just to see the doctor; the longer people live the higher the chance of developing a chronic illness," said Blalock, as she noted that early medical intervention is key. "In general, family medicine can take care of most things, I am able to follow them from my clinic to the hospital and who knows them better than I, the one who has been taking care of them the whole time and that continuity of care is essential."


In addition to obstetrics and geriatric care, Blalock and her staff provide routine physical exams, women's health, sports medicine and their office is one of the only in the area to offer Department of Transportation medical exams and commercial motor vehicle certification.

When discussing the boundaries that are normally built between doctor and patient, she said that her patients are adept at building those boundaries on their own, allowing Blalock to enjoy living and working in her hometown.

"When they are here in my office, I am Dr. Blalock and when I am seen out in town or we are in church, then I am Katie," said Blalock. "Sometimes they call me Dr. Katie, because they say I have earned it but I always tell them if you have known me since before I was born, please, just call me Katie."

As the choir director for her local church, Blalock can often be found attending services or even playing off-season music in her office, such as Easter hymns during the Thanksgiving week. She said that being able to interact with her patients on a multitude of levels has allowed her to be a doctor in the office but just a community member elsewhere.

"I have been told as we are going through the line for Wednesday night dinner at church, 'Now, Doc, don't judge.' I always tell them there are no calories at church and I will only judge when the cholesterol numbers come back but in general I want to be a regular part of the community," said Blalock. "Being able to interact with my patients, there is a trust that gets built. It allows me to better care for my patients so they are not hiding anything from me, that doesn't help anyone, but being outside of this office and not being a doctor for a little bit is good for me, and it is good for them too."





Sometimes, I might be painting at home- at 3:30 in the morning, in my husband, Matt's recliner (don't tell him if you see a little paint drip on it somewhere) or sometimes I may be pulled over on the side of the road taking photos of the sunset, or a lonely tree, or more than likely yelling at Talli, over her Airpods, "hurry!!! get your phone out and take a pic of that for me- no questions. Just do it!" as I'm driving past who knows what at 75 mph. She actually took this photo of me, so she's great at it!! But, I've been this way

since I was her age, drawing pictures in the mud at my grandmother's house on Nolan Street, so the best thing about painting and art is that it's more just a part of me than it is a job! Hopefully, one day, it will be the same
