Fairfield will match-up with the Brownfield Lady Cubs in the State Finals on Wednesday, March 10, at 2 p.m. at the Alamodome in San Antonio.

The Lady Eagles are looking to claim their second state championship in a row. Last year, Fairfield defeated Dal-

Sophomore McKinna Brackens is headed to her second State Championship game this Wednesday, March 10, as the Lady Eagles take on the Brownfield Lady Cubs in the Class 3A State Championship.

The Lady Eagles entered the playoffs with a 21-2 overall record. Their two losses were to 4A Brownsboro 64-58 and 5A Bryan Rudder 72-64.

Fairfield made it look easy this season dominating everyone in district play and claiming the District 20-3A title with an undefeated 14-0 district record.

The Lady Eagles defeated the Cameron Lady Yoes in the Bi-Distirct Championship at Bryan High School 89-31.

Breyunna Dowell led the way for Fairfield with 22 points. Jarahle Daniels added 19 points, Shadasia Brackens 17 points, McKinna Brackens 10 points, Essence Watkins 8 points, Emori Davis 6 points, Te'Yalla Simpson 3 points, and Charlee Brackens and Makensy Isaacs 2 points each. In the Area Championship, Fairfield knocked-off the Whitney Lady Wildcats 75-49 at Robinson High School.
