Aiming for the target a mile-high

While many people will be watching the Super Bowl while tucked inside the comfort of their homes, another group of enthusiasts will be participating in its own gridiron fest the annual WesTex Run n' Gun. This ultimate test of endurance will feature running and marksmanship at Historic Prude Ranch in the Davis Mountains.

This five-mile biathlon event, held Friday through Sunday, Feb. 11-13, is not for the faint of heart. Possessing the strength and stamina to withstand rugged terrain while running, and being able to shoot on target are

some of the core competencies tested.

"If this were easy, there'd be a lot more people who would want to do it," said Bruce Davis, general manager of Prude Ranch. "It's not an easy event. Thirty percent of your scores are how fast you run the course, and 70 percent of your scores are how well you do at the

shooting stations." Traditionally held on Super Bowl weekend, the run n' gun events take place all over Texas, and Davis started

one in 2016 at the ranch. He said the president of Prude Ranch, Bill Caruth, who has a home in Fort Davis, connected with Davis to start a biathlon for summer campers at the ranch using 22-caliber rifles. Though the gun n' run tests a variety of skills such as speed and quickness, along with tactical ability and coping with pressure situations, safety is of the utmost importance, and is emphasized thoroughly.

"This is a firearmrelated activity, and you've got to have training and upmost of care and expertise when you're messing with firearms in any way," said Davis.

Some stations alternate between rifle and handgun shooting, and there is a time limit on each station. Participants must carry their own ammo and water,


West Texas Safari Club donates to scholarship endowment

Filing period continues for municipal elections

The filing period for May 7 municipal election continues until Friday, Feb. 18, at close of business, and potential candidates can file only during that period.

For the City of Alpine, the mayor position and city council seats for Wards 2 and 4 are up this year. For the Alpine ISD Board of Trustees, Single Member Districts 5 and 7 will come up in May, and for the Big Bend Hospital District, Districts 2 and 4 will open up.

As of press time, only school teacher Catherine Eaves had filed for the city mayor position; incumbents Mary Mc-Callister for AISD Single Member, Dist.7, and Justin Cross for AISD Single Member Dist. 5; for the Hospital District, incumbents James "Cuatro" White for Single Member Dist. 2 and Buddy Cavness for Single Member Dist. 4.

To file for the city positions, visit cityofalpine.com, and scroll down to Municipal Elections. Forms and complete information can be found there.

For school board positions, see Marsha Roach at the Alpine ISD administration building at the corner of Sul Ross Avenue and 11th Street; and for the hospital district, call J.D. Newsom at 432-837-7051.

No fees are required to file for any of these elections.

Raising taxes on city's radar

The City of Alpine held its regularly scheduled city council meeting on Feb. 1, and taxes led the discussion.

"We don't necessarily want to raise taxes. I know that's it's never something that council wants to ask, but after so many years of not raising it, you become stagnant," Interim City Manager Megan Antrim said. "You can't keep moving forward because you don't have any money coming in. That is where we are at. Your money has got to come in from somewhere, and your two biggest sources right now are sales tax and property tax."

One to two percent options were offered, with Antrim contemplating what would be the effect on the community and the budget, along with the best interests of the city.

Director of Utilities Keith Segar then provided a report, and Mayor Andy Ramos commented on the city's aging infrastructure, saying, "In the past, city council has been reluctant to

go out for monies to rehab the infrastructure, and it's catching up to us. We are



in a serious situation, and we just cannot just put a bandaid on it anymore. It's not just a matter of raising the taxes, it's where they are going to."

Segar hoped federal funding might be available but said the issue was an "inconvenient truth." Next, Antrim provided an EMS update, indicating that during its last meeting, Big Bend Regional Hospital District took no action as far as taking over EMS after April 30. She said it was Brewster County's responsibility to provide EMS services, and Big Bend Regional Medical Center also expressed

interest. Nevertheless, cost would be a significant consideration.

Antrim added, "This is going to be a business, it is going to cost me, and I'm going to pass on those costs on to you."

Big Bend Regional Hospital District Director J.D. Newsom added he was anticipating a proposal from the hospital from a hospital-based EMS service.

In other business, the council thoroughly discussed the proposed contract with Austin-based waste collection service TDS, and Rick Fraumann and City Attorney Rod Ponton reviewed the entirety of the contract. The issue will be up for a vote at the next city council meeting.

TDS proposed a threeyear, five-year, and 10year option for the contract with the city. Some of the issues discussed

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were the city's landfill, illegal dumping, the Hal Flanders Recycling Center and its use for county residents, and rates that TDS would charge the city for the services.

Finally, Lisa Fielder of Chisos Brewery provided an update on the proposed craft brewery, which would be located on Murphy Street. Fielder said the brewery would benefit the city financially with increased tourism and added, "Our goal is to lure them at least overnight, so they patronize nearby businesses, other bars in the region, hotels, and we hope to bring general prosperity."

The next regularly scheduled city council meeting is set for Tuesday, Feb. 15 at 5:30 p.m. in the city council chambers and via Zoom videoconferencing.

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

Texas, our Texas flag

"Honor the Texas flag; I pledge allegiance to thee, Texas, one state under God, one and indivisible."

Children across our state recite this pledge at the start of every school day. Placing their right hands over their hearts, they take a moment to pause and appreciate the independent spirit of our beloved Lone Star State.

Many identify this famous moniker with the Texas flag, which proudly bears a single white star. But the story of our flag's design and unusual history deserves to be shared, especially as we celebrated its 183rd anniversary on Jan. 25.

In 1839 the Republic of Texas adopted the bold flag as a symbol of our fierce independence. Each color represents a staple characteristic of our state - red for bravery, white for purity,

of Fredonia, a short-lived Republic near modern-day Nacogdoches that seceded from Mexico in the 1820s. The famous single star represents all Texans standing together for God, state, and country.

Before our current flag cemented its place in history, two others shared some time in the spotlight, though both were eventually removed. Stephen F. Austin and Lorenzo de Zavala created their own ideas for the Texas flag, but neither of these ideas was formally ad-

opted. In 1839, the national flag was approved, marking the official beginning of our state's present-day flag. While the original master-

While the original mastermind of our beloved flag is still unknown, some speculate the creator of the Lone Star flag may have been Montgomery County resident and former representative in the Texas Congress, Charles B. Stewart. It is said his sketches looked suspiciously similar to those of Peter Krag's design, which would ultimately become the flag we know and love today. Stewart's drawings even included an interesting detail from some of Krag's previous artwork – an upside-down copy of Republic of Texas President Mirabeau Lamar's signature.

After the legislation to make the flag the official symbol of the Republic of

Texas introduced in 1838, it wasn't long before Texas joined the Union in 1845, and brought our beloved flag with us. From 1879-1933, Texas was technically flagless due to a state civil statutes revision which did not renew the flag code but in 1933 the Texas Flag Code was enacted, finally codifying our state flag.

Today, the Texas flag serves as one of only two state flags that have doubled as a national flag, the other being Hawaii.

While six flags have flown over Texas, the one we know and love today has withstood the test of time. Whenever we catch a glimpse of the Lone Star flag billowing in the wind, let's take a moment to thank our lucky stars for that unwavering symbol of freedom

1.1 INVITATION

The City of Alpine (City) Texas and Brewster County invite experienced and qualified emergency service providers to submit proposals to provide emergency advanced life support (ALS) ambulance services as specified in this document for the City of Alpine and North Brewster County.

1.2 SYSTEM DESIGN

This is a request for qualifications (RFQ) for emergency services for the City of Alpine, Texas and North Brewster County. The system design requires Advanced Life Support to stop the response time clock and 2 paramedics for transport. If first responders provide initial ALS, a transport unit response time shall be required.

1.3 DESCRIPTION OF CITY OF ALPINE

City of Alpine is the county seat of Brewster County and located in the northern area. The City is comprised of an estimated 6,000 citizens. Alpine is located on U.S. Highway 90 about 26 miles (42 km) east of Marfa and 31 mils west of Marathon. Services are also being requested to cover North Brewster County, which includes the town of Marathon. North Brewster County includes coverage of Hwy 118 to Jeff Davis County Line, Hwy 67 to Pecos County Line, Hwy North and South 118 to Presidio County and Terrell County lines.

1.4 MEDICAL CONTROL

Medical Director - The City does not currently contract with a physician to serve as Medical Director. The provider will need to provide their own Medical Director with substantial experience in the practice of emergency medicine, to provide medical control and to assure medical accountability throughout the planning, implementation, and evaluation of the local EMS system.

Treatment Protocols - Providers will need to provide to the City and County for review as a part of their packet Advanced Life Support (ALS), Basic Life Support (BLS), Pediatric policies and protocols, and trauma scoring used by first responders, EMT-1s, paramedics, mobile intensive care nurses (MICNs), and Base Hospital physicians to provide care to patients in the field. These policies and protocols must be approved by the City and County. The policies and procedures shall undergo regular review and revision.

On-Line – Providers must be able to provide communication infrastructure such that authorized mobile intensive care nurses (MICNs) and base hospital physicians (BHP) can communicate directly with paramedics during the care and transport of emergency patients.

Retrospective Review - Providers must provide assurances for retrospective review by the base hospital, service providers, and EMS Agency to ensure quality patient care by reviewing care received by patients.



Sul Ross gets state money

The Texas State University System has received more than \$60 million in state support for Sul Ross State University, including an historic investment of more than \$59 million for capital projects in the university's two service regions. The funding, secured by TSUS leadership during the 2021 legislative sessions, includes \$33.1 million for multi-purpose education buildings in the Rio Grande College service area, \$26.4 million toward renovations of fine arts buildings in Alpine, and \$1 million in recurring state general revenue support to enhance the university's student success initiatives.

"This funding for Sul Ross represents an historic investment in South and West Texas, and will go very far to help give our students the tools needed to prepare them for meaningful careers in Texas' robust work-

force," said Texas House Speaker Dade Phelan. "I commend the Texas State University System for continuing to make Sul Ross a priority, and

for laying out a thoughtful process to

ensure the best use of these funds."

TSUS institutions will receive a combined \$422.6 million in capital project support under Senate Bill 52, the capital construction assistance bill passed by the Legislature in the third special session of 2021.

Wintemute stressed it was not a requirement for candidates to be within the Texas State University System. He said McCall was considering a wide range of higher education leaders both within and outside of the system.

"One of the reasons the chancellor decided to appoint an interim president at this time rather than launch a fullscale national search is to have someone who can come in and continue to focus on meeting institutional goals that are important for everyone without losing momentum in that process," said Wintemute.

He noted national presidential searches were time consuming and resource intensive, and could sometimes lead to institutions putting long term initiatives on pause until a new president was identified and brought on board.

"This will allow the important work of the institution, faculty, and staff to continue without disruption," said Wintemute.

No goal or timeline for appointing a permanent president was in place beyond expecting the interim to serve through the end of the 2022-2023 academic

sometime in the spring, but all decisions are up to the Board of Directors, who makes the final determination.

According to van Zeyst, there has been a significant increase in the number of seniors who need meals delivered to them via Meals on Wheels, as more have been homebound. Previously around 150 clients asked for the service, and that number is now around 260.

"In our area we don't have any nursing homes anymore, and we don't have any long-term care facilities, so it's important that we try to keep people in their homes," explained van Zeyst. "We have an ag-

ing population in Alpine, so it's important that we do our part to keep them in their own home safely, with good nutrition, with the mobility equipment that we have, and that helps that whole cross section of our population."

The Sunshine House also has medical equipment that can be loaned out to seniors, including mobility equipment such as walkers, canes, and more. For clients who are mobile, they can still check out newspapers, magazines, books, greeting cards, DVDs, and more from Sunshine House, and may use the public wi-fi while they are outside on the bench-

Van Zeyst credited Brewster County and the generous businesses and donors who have contributed to the center, along with the Sunshine House staff who make sure everything runs smoothly. She is gratified to be working with a dedicated and zealous team to continue to fulfill the Sun-

shine House mission. Despite some limited programs, there are plans to bring back the popular Wild West fundraiser later in the year, and van Zeyst is hopeful it can be in person again.


"Our biggest challenge is getting back open in person," she said. "That is going to be the big hurdle and the big joy, and the biggest accomplishment this year is just getting back a little more towards normality, and how we were before COVID came along. We are looking forward to the day when we can have all of our clients inside with us again, and everybody can enjoy the senior center."

and cannot run with a loaded firearm. Range officers are on hand at each station, and are military veterans or former law enforcement officers. Avocados not a cold-hardy plant

Dear Neil: This is our Lila avocado. I set it in our garage with a heat lamp last February. It survived, although it had no fruit. Now the slit in the trunk has become much worse. Do you think it will make it?

It looks like the trunk and bark are extremely compromised. It appears to be trying to heal, but only time will tell. Assuming the tree does survive, the pot won't be large enough as it grows and develops. You'll need a much larger container. Hopefully it will heal enough to bear for you. Keep it moist at all times, and protect it from freezing temperatures. You lose a lot of winter-hardiness

when you have a plant's root system above ground, and avocados don't have much hardiness in the first place. Good luck with it!


Dear Neil: We have almost a dozen Italian cypress trees in our backyard. They thought we saw spider webs on some. What would cause this browning, and what can we do to save

Spider mites do attack Italian cypress. They usually start toward the bottoms of the plants, and flush upward and outward. Assuming you have not applied any type of insecticide or miticide, the best way to tell for sure is to thump a branch that is starting to turn brown (but not already brown) over a sheet of white paper. If you can see ultra-tiny (almost microscopic) specks of reddish-brown starting to move around on the paper after 20-30 that attacks cypress and junipers will show up in winter, unlike the ones we see on tomatoes, beans, marigolds, and so many other plants in the summer. If you see the mites, spray the plants thoroughly with a general-purpose

The browned needles won't green up again, however. You may ultimately decide that you need to replace them just to get a better look to your landscape. I'd suggest Oakland holly as an upright shrub that

is better suited and more easily maintained.

Awards continue to pour in for football team


Canaba signs with Hardin-Simmons
