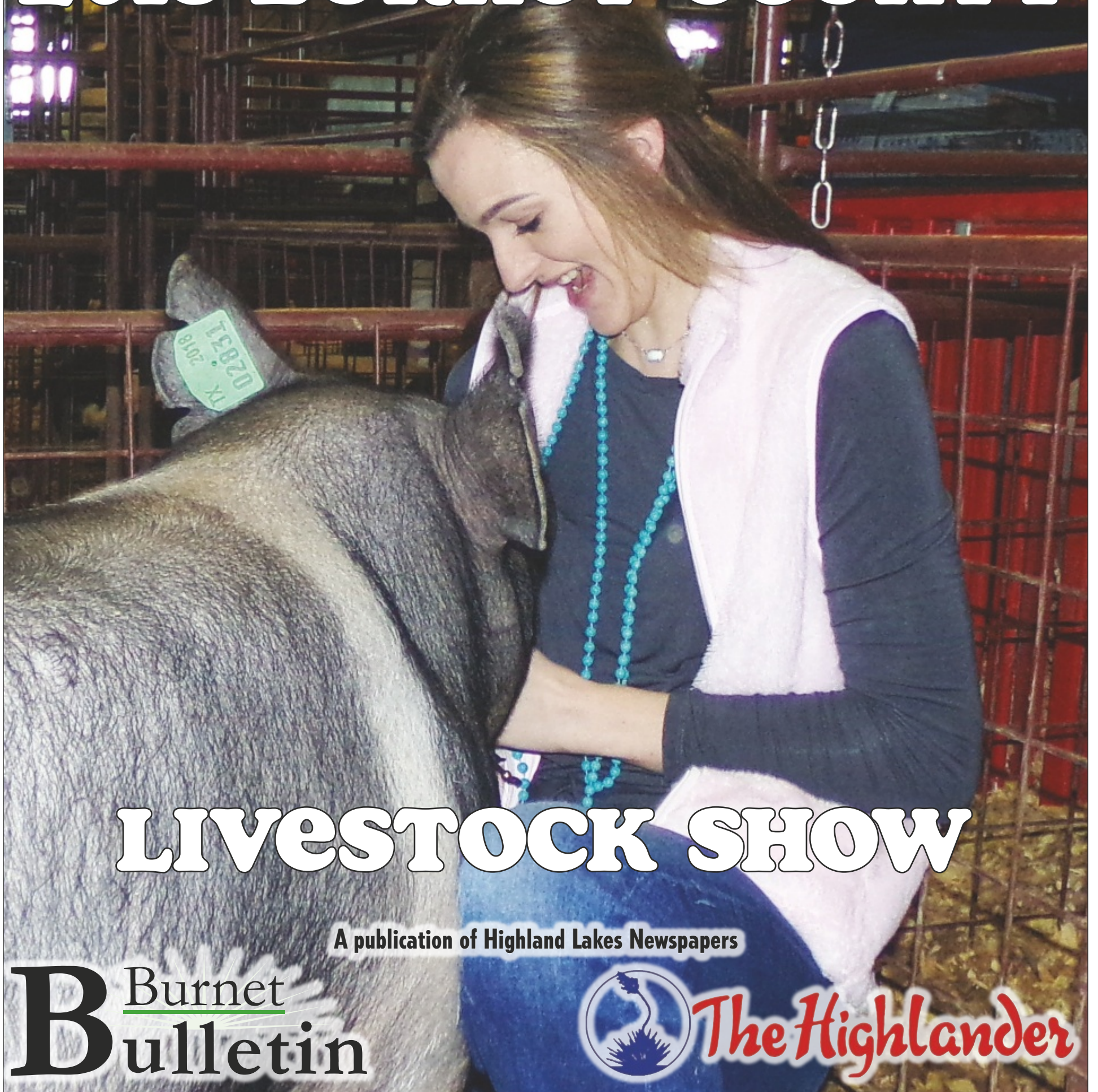

Livestock Show is family tradition

Tradition is what binds generations of families together, and in Burnet County, one tradition which has continued for decades is the annual Burnet County Livestock Show, which celebrated 51 years of competition this month.

During that time, the Burnet County FFA and 4-H Livestock Show has grown from a small event to a premier livestock show for area youth, raising thousands of dollars to help FFA and 4-H students while providing a positive outlet for young people to learn valuable life skills.

Livestock Show Chairman Brandon Evans knows firsthand the value of the show, having been a former exhibitor at the show.

"I grew up in this county and it is a great source of pride I have being able to raise my children in the same county that supported me at a young age," said Evans, who has served on the board of directors for four years and as chairman for three.

"Most, if not all, of the volunteers currently have children showing, have had children show or themselves showed as a child. Many of the directors grew up and showed at the livestock show themselves."

Evans said the livestock show is "truly a unique program that is family oriented to grow our communities' young people."

"It is so much more than just raising a pig or a goat," he said. "It is the life skills that are taught and learned through these

projects that make it different than other programs children are involved in."

Throughout the years, the show has grown by leaps and bounds.

In 1967, the first year of the show, the sale raised \$2,100 with 100 animals shown.

The champion steer that year was shown by Bobby Ebeling, with Jackie Wright showing the champion lamb and Sammy Montoya the champion broilers.

Steve Roper had two champions,

with the champion hog and splitting champion turkey with Ronnie Sauer.

The Ebeling family would go on to great success in the Burnet County Livestock Show in the area of showing steers.

Bobby had the grand champion steer in 1967 and 1968, while Nancy had the reserve champion in 1967 and then took the grand champion four years in a row from 1969 through 1972.

In 1973 and 1974, it was Steve Ebeling, a future board member of the show, who took the grand champion title.

Vicki Ebeling took the grand champion in 1975 and the next generation of Ebelings would come to prominence in the late 1980s and early 1990s with Holli and Justin Ebeling winning trophies for their champion steers.

By the early 1980s, the show brought in \$106,742.60, eclipsing \$100,000 for the first time. But a big change would come to the show in 1991, which was the silver anniversary for the Burnet County Livestock Show.

That year, instead of an auction, the show featured its first premium sale. No longer

would exhibitors be parted from their animals by being paid full market price for an animal, but instead would be paid a premium or bonus the buyer wished to pay.

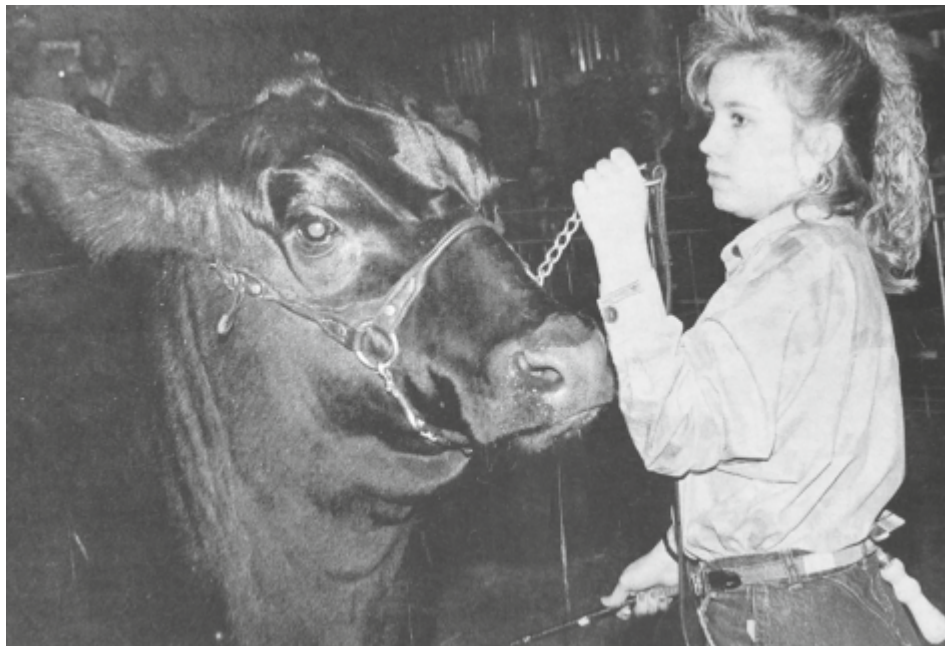
This change allowed students to keep their animals so they could take them to other shows, yet still raised money for the Burnet County youth who exhibited.

The show has weathered a lot over the years, including the weather. A big ice storm hit during the week of the show in 1997 — 21 years ago — but a break in the inclement weather allowed the show and sale to go on, which was a good thing with more than 670 entrants that year.

Last year, the show raised more than \$420,000, a new record for the Burnet County show and a testament to the growth of what is the county's premier event for FFA and 4-H youth.

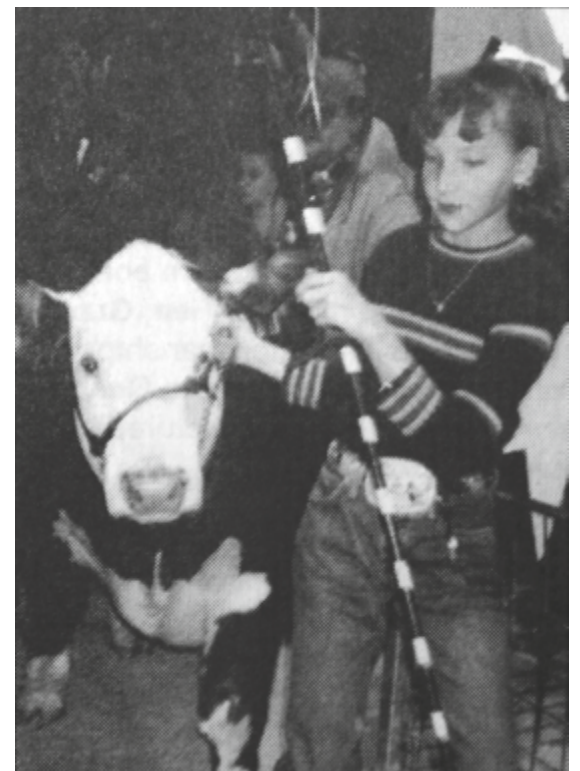
"It's neat to see the changes in sales totals from the first year to the second year in growth to where we are currently," Evans said. "We have come a long way! We have had 50 years of history and the community support has continued to grow."

"We could not have the success that we have seen without the countless hours our volunteers, parents and our FFA advisors and 4-H specialist have devoted to this event."

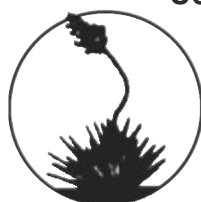

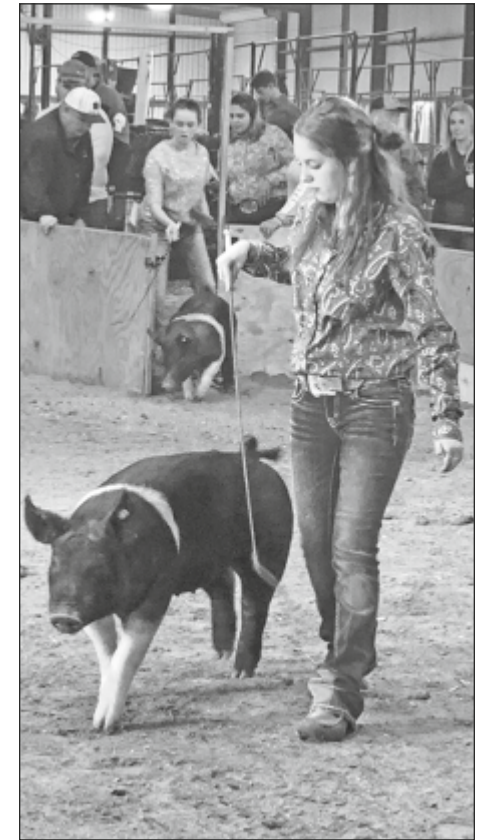

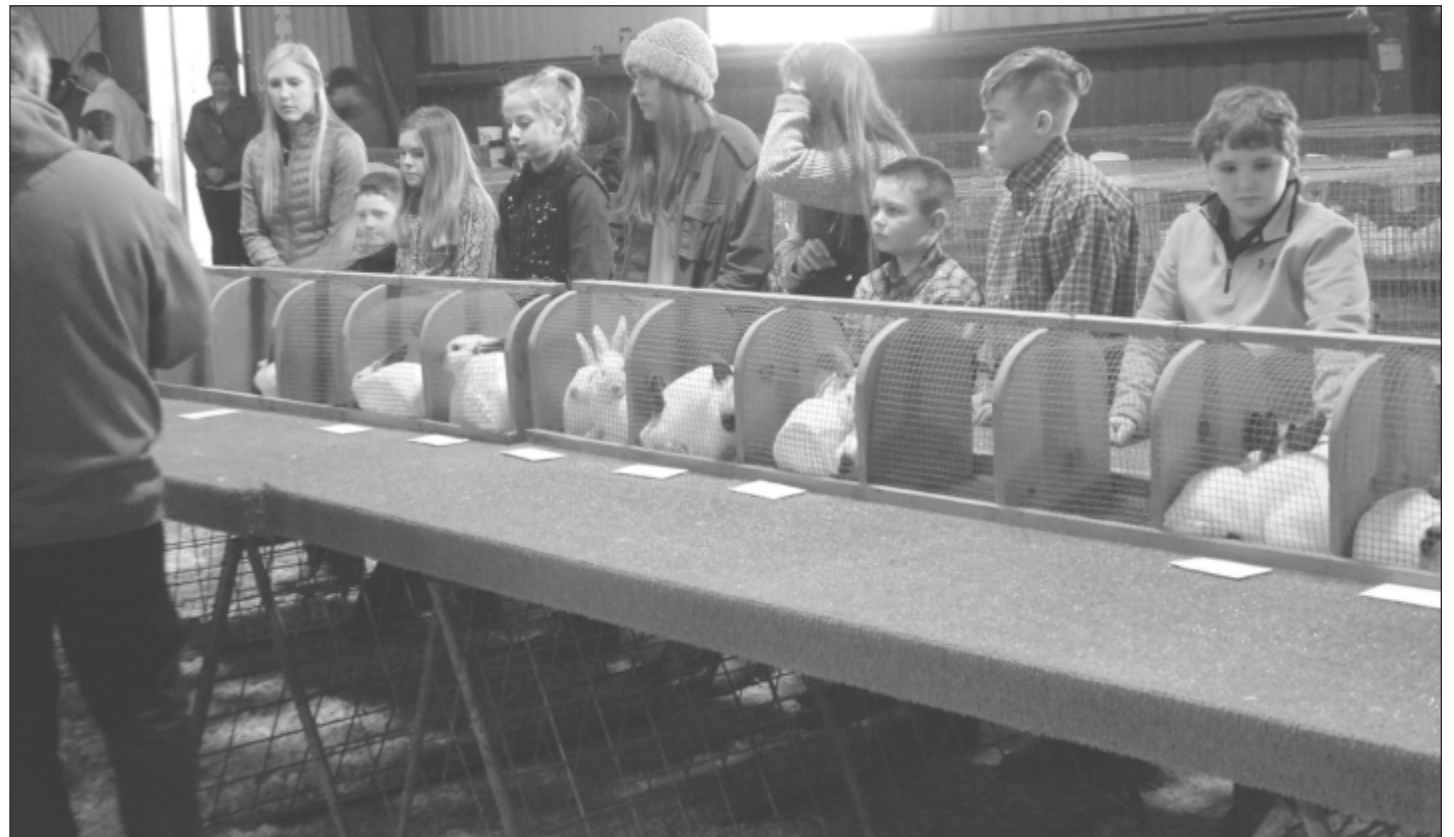

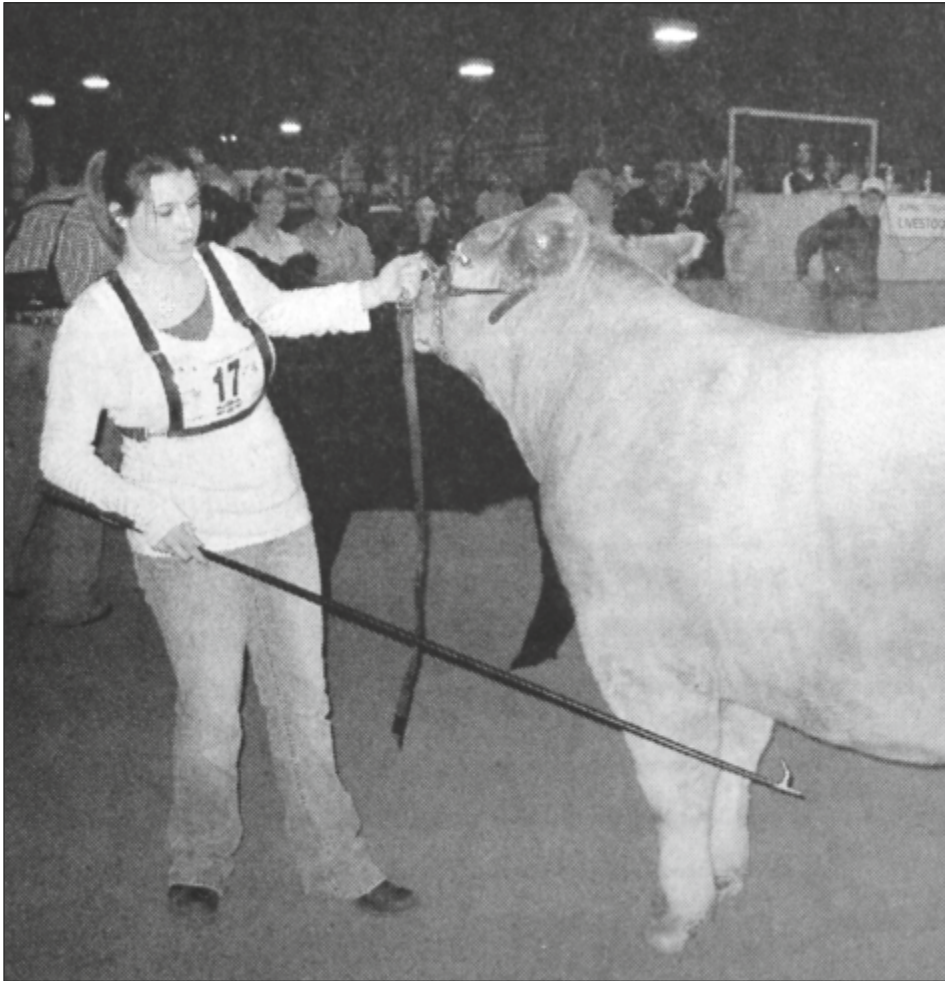

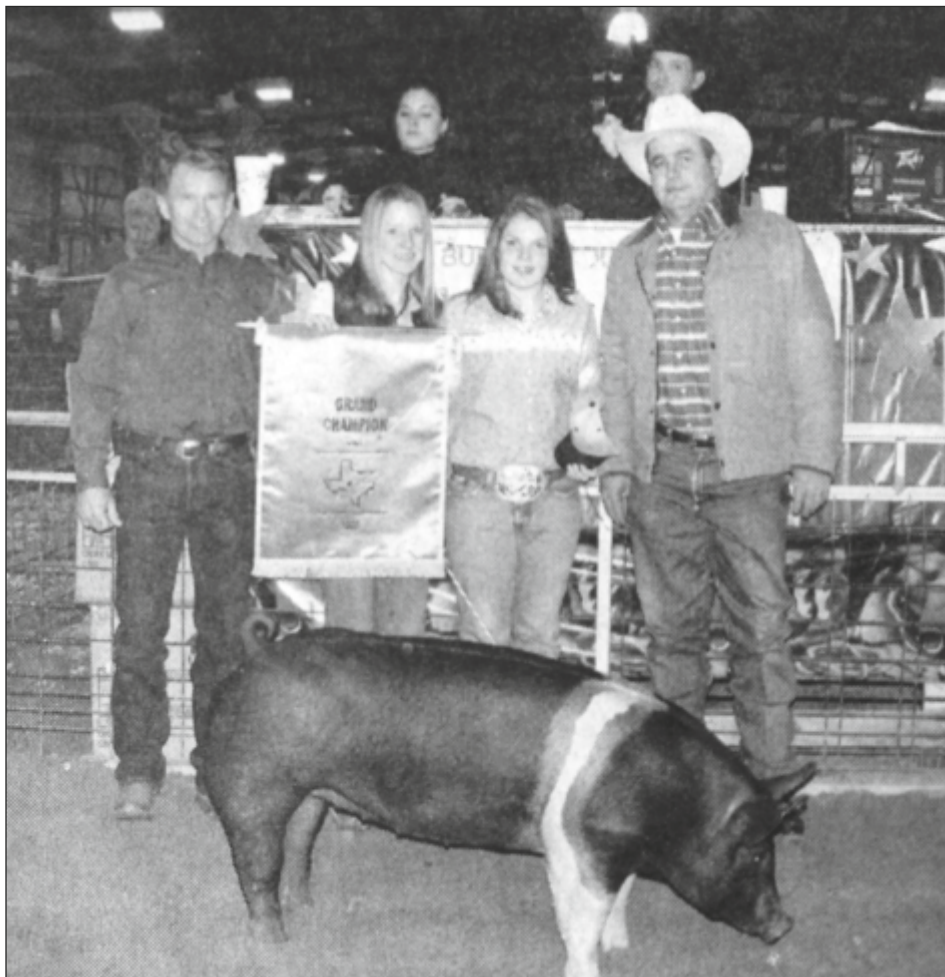

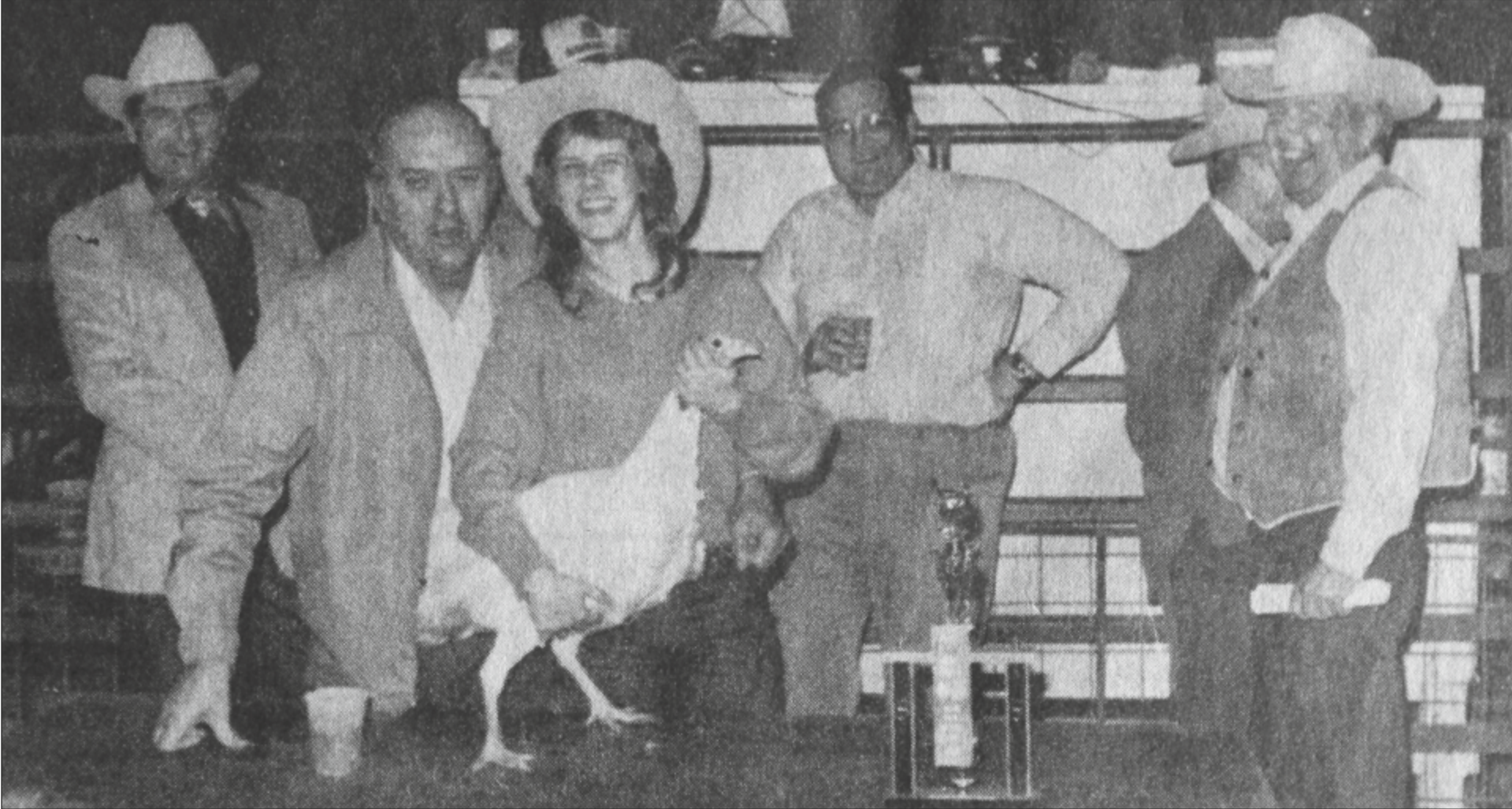
